Dear David:

Last month my husband had a meeting in Baltimore and, since we had no other vacation plans, I decided to try to work in some genealogical research. We went to Northumberland Co. and then to Lebanon and Philadelphia on our way to Baltimore and had a couple of days in New Jersey after the meeting. There was not much time spent any where, but I did some work on Joseph Wilson and found his Will, and we made two copies of it so that you can have one.

You will notice that the Will was probated in Columbia Co., Pa, not in North-umberland. Before we left I did a little research on the history. Northumberland Co. at one time covered a large area of northern Pennsylvania. In 1813, when Columbia was formed, Chillisquaque Township became part of Columbia. On 21 Feb 1815 Turbot and Chillisquaque Townships were reannexed to Northumberland. However, Joseph Wilson died 4 January 1815, which meant that his Will would have been probated in Columbia Co. Just less that a year later on 22 Jan 1816 parts of these two townships were put back into Columbia Co. Much later, 3 May 1850 Columbia Co. was divided and Montour formed, so that Chillisquaque, (the part in Columbia) then became a township of Montour Co. There is still a Chillisquaque Township in Northumberland Co., in fact two - East and West - but the Wilsons evidently lived east of Potts Grove in what is now Montour Co.

He names three sons: William, John & Nathaniel, and Nathaniel's son, Joseph Wilson. He names the daughters rather oddly, giving them all the name of Wilson, rather than their married name. Since we know that Ann was married to William Taylor by this time and had a son, Joseph W. Taylor, I assume that Mary, who had a son Joseph W. Van Horn was also married and her husband's name was _____ Van Horn. The daughters in the order he names them, which I believe is probably the order of birth of the daughters are: Nancy, Mary, Ann, Betsy, Sally, Nelly & Martha. Since he leaves 4 of the daughters bed and bedding in addition to the cash, it is likely that they were not yet married.

We took information from all Wilson Wills in Columbia Co up to 1850, and in Montour Co. until 1866, but I have not been able to reconcile families from them. There is an Elizabeth who died in 1866, residence Liberty Twp. Montour Co., which is close to where they lived, and she may be Joseph's daughter Betsy. She names sisters: Agnes Wilson, who could be the Nancy in Joseph's Will as these names are sometimes interchanged; Sarah Cole, Martha Waugh and Letitia Wilson. This would give us surnames for Sally and Martha, but leaves the question of Letitia. She would have to be Nelly, and it may not be impossible that Nelly was a family name for Letitia. Ann is not mentioned, but she had died by then. There are other discrepancies, though. She also names nieces: Margaret Vaughan, Mary Mathers, Elizabeth Kitchen, Ellen Keeler and Charity Gillespie. These could be married names for them, but there are nephews William D. Vaughan, Joseph Wilson, and Joshua Davis Wilson. To reconcile this the names Vaughan here may be Van Horn, which may not be impossible.

Elizabeth provided for her burial at Chillisquaque Church Cemetery. There are 3 graves in front of the group where Joseph & Mary are: Catharine d/o John & Margaret Wilson, d. March 17, 1954 (could not read age, or it was not there); Elizabeth Wilson b. Dec 11, 1784 and d. Dec. 10, 1866 a. 82y; and Elizabeth w/o William Wilson, d. March 20, 1852 a. (69y?) and 6d. This looks as if Elizabeth could be the daughter of John & Margaret, but I have their Wills and they have no daughter Elizabeth. Even with the differences, it appears that this Elizabeth may be the daughter of Joseph.

I also tried to get something about the land ownership. We began in Northumberland Co. because that would be the earliest record, if it was recorded then. Sometimes deeds were not recorded till years later. Things are not too clear here, either. Benjamin Dean agreed to sell a certain piece of property to Joseph and Robert Wilson in 1774. In June 1776 Joseph relinquished his share to Robert for 5 shillings. The deed from Dean is not dated until 25 Oct 1777 when both of the above deeds were recorded. There is one deed from Michael Troy to Joseph Wilson, dated 2 Oct 1775 for 100 acres, but we don't have any deed out of Joseph for this. In Columbia Co. there is a deed from Joseph to William Clark, dated 21 Mar 1804 and recorded 27 Oct 1814 which refers to a Patent dated 1 March 1804 to Joseph Wilson for £300. Patent recorded at Lancaster Co., Patent Book #53, page 341. This record would be at Harrisburg. It contained 245 acres 12 perches and allowance of 6% for roads. I plotted this and it is a strange shaped piece, rather long and thin.

If I can get any of this sorted out, I will write it up and see that you get it. I think we may need more information in order to do it, though.

I have the 1790 census for Pennsylvania and the Index for the 1800 one. The 1790 census for Northumberland Co. is not divided by townships, but it is not listed alphabetically, so it is possible to tell when similar names are located near each other. I have taken the information and will make a copy of it and also of the names involving Wilson in the 1800 Index. I notice that there was a Robert Van Horn in Northumberland in 1800, but no Vaughan. In 1790 there were two: Daniel and William Van Horn, or as it is recorded Vanhorn. Depending on how it is written Vanhorn and Vaughan are not too dissimilar, and someone copying a Will could have misread it.

This will give you a little more, and something to think about. I was not working on the Wilsons in New Jersey, but on my Young family, without any success. Hope all is well with you.

Dear David:

It has taken me a little while to get some of this material put together. I have a man doing some research for me in Ohio, and he has kept me busy getting materials ready for him. He has filled in quite a lot of detail on one of my mother's lines, so I can't complain.

I am sending the typed Wills for both William and Ann Taylor, which you wanted. In addition is a copy of the article on the Depreciation and Donation Lands which I wrote for the QUARTERLY of the Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society, and a copy of the separations and mergers of the various Presbyterian Churches. This is very helpful in keeping track of what happened to the various individual congregations.

I am not sending anything on the deed because it needs work done on it. I have spent quite a bit of time on the deed from the Pennsylvania Population Company to John Sprott because it was from that deed that William Taylor's farm came from. However, there is a mistake, as I told you, in the description, and in order to figure out what it should be I will have to go to the Courthouse in Beaver and see if the deeds which are on the boundaries will clear up the problem. I think I know what it should be, but can't rely on that. I don't know when I might be able to get to Beaver.

I do have an abstract of William Taylor's deed, but should have the complete deed for him, so I can do that at the same time. I just realized in going over the Sprott deed that there was a John Chambers on one of the boundaries. I feel pretty sure that he was probably the father of the James Chambers who married Nancy Taylor, and if I can find a Will for him, it might clear up some problems involved with her descendants.

It was most interesting to hear from you and I am anxious to get the material you have on the Taylor family for me. I have now gotten a copy of the Geological Survey which includes the cemetery of Potts Grove. The Quadrangle I had didn't have the cemetery on it. There is a map store here which carries all the local ones, but which will order the others for you. I wanted some others for Lebanon Co. so got them at the same time. Now all I need to do is find time to make a trip there to see what I can find in the Courthouse.

When I write again I will send copies of the Family Group Sheets for all your families, and would appreciate it if you would check what I have to see if it is accurate with your material. Much of mine comes from the Taylor Family History, and I know it is not accurate. In addition I do have a little from other sources.

His father, C. W. Taylor, who was justice of the peace for many years in this county married Mary, daughter of W. W. Willis, of New Brighton, and they had eight chil dren, C. W. being the eldest. Joseph Taylor, grandfather of our subject, came to America from England. C. W. attended public school in New Brighton until he was fifteen years of age; was then employed on the railroad and some time afterward engaged in pottery business. For a number of years he was employed as a salesman, and held other positions in connection with potteries. He was married, in 1880, to Jennie daughter of John Rupert and grand-daughter of Casper Weitzell. They have two children: Annie and Lila.

THOMAS M. TAYLOR, merchant, justice of the peace and notary public, Rochester was born in this county March 31, 1818, a son of William and Ann (Wilson) Taylor, the latter born in Pennsylvania, of German descent, and the former born in Ireland. Will iam came to America in 1798, and to Pennsylvania when a mere lad, soon afterward locating in Darlington, this county. He served in the War of 1812, and was a farmer all his life; his family consisted of eleven children, all of whom grew to maturity, and were all married before a death occurred in the family. Our subject's eldest brother John Taylor, who was born in Northumberland county, in 1802, now resides on a farm in Iowa. Thomas M., who is the youngest of five brothers, was reared in Beaver county, attending the public schools and the Greersburg Academy, at Darlington. He clerked in a store and on a steamboat in early life, and subsequently embarked in mer cantile trade at Rochester, at which place he was appointed postmaster in 1862, serving fifteen years. Since then he has been justice of the peace and notary public. He also daughter of Daniel Skillenger, and a native of Beaver county; her parents were born in the New England States. Mr. and Mrs. Taylor's only son, Eugene W., now deceased was a physician in practice in Venango county, Pa., at the time of his death. He was married and left two children. William and Thomas carries on the boot and shoe trade in Rochester. He was married, in 1845, to Margaret He has been a member of the I. O. O. F. for thirty-six years.




